








Report: Proposed Projects from 2017

- Power washing of Stone Wall


Landscaping for Sign for the Park

Park Pond

- Purchased Mosquito Fish to control mosquito larva
- Added fish three times during the year due to fluxuating water levels
 - 12 fish per time
 - Cost: \$1 per fish

Stone Wall

- Need for Pressure Washing in 2018
 - □ > \$3500
 - Apply Mold retardant
- Need to keep shrubs, vines, and trees away from the wall
 - Reduce molds, etc.
 - Need assistance from Home Owners
- Landscaping trimming

Mail Boxes

- Issues removing mail from current boxes
 - Different opening size issues
- Investigate what other options maybe


Yards Signs

 - May need Yard Service assistance
 - Weed and Feed
- Top soil depletion
- Add compose

Garbage Cans


- Recycling containers add to the problem

 - Must no be visible from street
- Removing trash / recycle containers from the street by <u>Wednesday evening</u>
- Handful of households not in compliance
 - Board ask for everyone's assistance
 - Garages / behind fences / etc.

Bulk Collection Guidelines

- Bulk collection is for large items such as tires, furniture and appliances.
- Remove doors from appliances, gas/oil from mowers and barbeque grills, and nails from lumber.
- Items will be picked up throughout the week.
- Visit austintexas.gov/bulk for more information.

Crews cannot collect **brush**, sheet glass, construction or remodeling debris, household garbage, cardboard boxes, auto parts, truck tires or chemicals such as paints, solvents or pool chemicals.

DO NOT:

- Place items in an alley or in front of a vacant lot.
- Place items in bags, boxes or personal garbage containers.

Residents can drop off appliances for recycling anytime at the Recycle & Reuse Drop-Off Center at 2514 Business Center Drive. For more details about drop-off, visit austintexas.gov/dropoff or call (512) 974-4373. For other questions, call Call 3-1-1


Know Your Neighbor


